TOWNSHIP COUNCIL DEDICATES JOHN P. MONAHAN MUNICIPAL BUILDING

The Bristol Township Council adopted a resolution dedicating the John P. (Jack) Monahan Municipal Building at their February 21, 2019 meeting. “It was a pleasure to honor Jack by naming the municipal building after him”, said Council President Craig Bowen.

Monahan began his service to Bristol Township back in 1964 when he served as the Township Secretary. He was the Township’s last Mayor in 2010 – 2011 prior to voters changing the form of government to its present Council-Strong Manager government. He also served as Council President and Vice-President during his several terms on the Township Council. “When you think of public service in Bristol Township, you cannot help but think of Jack Monahan”, said Bowen.

Mr. Monahan also served as a legislative aide to the Township’s State Representative for over 25 years and was the Sergeant at Arms to the House of Representatives in Harrisburg. He also represented Bristol Township on the Lower Bucks County Joint Municipal Authority for many years.

Pursuant to the adopted resolution, a plaque will be installed in the municipal building honoring John Monahan.

Monahan was also presented Commendations from State Senator Tommy Tomlinson’s and State Representative Tina Davis’s offices.
