Adam Flager announced that personnel, litigation, and real estate matters were discussed in Executive Session prior to the meeting.

President Bowen announced that monthly reports are available for review in the Township Manager's Office and public comment on land development and official items will be taken during the meeting. In addition, residents may offer general comments at the of the meeting. President Bowen also announced that he will be stepping down as Council President in 2021.

A. Presentation of Monthly Recycling Awards for Exemplary Recycling Performance.

President Bowen Presented a \$50 Gift Certificate to the Ryan Family of Bloomsdale and the Hunt Family of Bristol.

B. Presentation on Blighted Property Recommendations.

Robert McTague, Building and Planning Supervisor stated as of today; 48 properties remain on the vacant home list down from 204 in 2015. Eight (8) homes are being recommended tonight for blight.

C. Public Hearing and Presentation on Substantial Amendment to FY2019 and FY2020 Action Plans.

Ms. Elton advised that the Township received a second round of CARES ACT Funding, so this Substantial Amendment is needed to allocate funding. Allocations of this funding include administration, funding to the homeless shelter, PPE for Lower Bucks Hospital, and mortgage relief to our residents.

D. Presentation and of Township Manager's Proposed Budget: Consideration to Authorize Advertisement of Notice of Availability for Public Inspection.

Ms. Elton advised that there would be no tax, trash or sewer rate increases for next year. We will continue to evaluate; probable trash and sewer rate increases in the future.

NEW BUSINESS

A. Application of Bristol Township Recycling Center, LLC, requesting Preliminary Land Development review to construct a Recycling Center on the property located at 2607 & 2513 Old Rogers Road, Bristol (Tax Parcels #5-24-51-001, #5-24-51 & #5-24-52) in a M-1 Light Manufacturing zoned district: Consideration to take Appropriate Action.

The Preliminary/Final/ Land Development Plans propose to demolish the existing building, construct a 46,475 square foot building, install concrete pads, truck scales, and pave the parking lot. The proposed use if for a Recycling Center which is permitted by right within the M1- Light Manufacturing Zoning District. The Wireless Communication Facility will remain on the lot. The lot will be serviced by the public water supply system and public sewage system. Stormwater runoff is to be controlled using and underground infiltration basin and trench drains.

Motion made by Mr. Antonello and seconded by Vice-President Murphy to approve the Preliminary & Final Land Development to construct a Recycling Center on the property located at 2607 & 2513 Old Rogers Road. Motion carried by a vote of 6-0.

B. Request for Proposals for 2020-2021 Snow Removal/Plowing Services: Consideration to take Appropriate Action.

Ms. Elton recommended to accept the 2020-2021 Snow Removal/Plowing Service Bid from Area Enclosures ,8'-91/2' Plow at \$150.00 per hour and Shades of Green, Inc, loader at \$360.00 per hour and Backhoe at \$250.00 per hour.

Motion made by Mrs. Wagner and seconded by Mr. Glasson to approve the 2020-2021 Snow Removal/Plowing Service Bid. Motion carried by a vote of 6-0.

C. Request for Proposals for 2020-2021 Tree Trimming and Removal Services: Consideration to take Appropriate Action.

Ms. Elton recommended to accept the 2020-2021 Tree Trimming and Removal Services from the only bidder, Shades of Green. Full day at \$167500, half day at 915.00, and Emergency Call in Fee at \$350.00.

Mrs. Wagner made a motion and seconded by Vice-President Murphy to approve the 2020-2021 Tree Trimming and Removal Services Bid. Motion carried by a vote of 6-0.

D. Conservation Easement for Bucks County Open Space Grant: Consideration to take Appropriate Action.

Ms. Elton explained this is the final step and required for reimbursement for the County Open Space Grant Funding for the Municipal Complex Park Expansion project.

Vice-President Murphy made a motion and seconded by Mr. Antonello to approve the Deed of Easement for the Bucks County Open Space Grant. Motion carried by a vote of 6-0.
